

## Janne Kronstam- NASA Championship Show 2024

Many thanks to the National Australian Shepherd Association for inviting me to the Cops & Robbers Show. What a brilliant fun show it was. I didn't realize until after the judging when I saw the videos just how much fun was going on ringside, and still all exhibitors were very professional in the ring. Amazing job the committee has put behind this show! My stewards were terrific, great fun and made sure I was on the right track all the time.

I was overwhelmed by the big entry. Exhibitors were all showing their dogs to perfection, and I was very pleased with the overall quality of the dogs. Especially my two Junior handlers did a wonderful job, not only as Juniors, but also, when they showed in regular classes.

All dogs seemed happy and friendly, which was a great pleasure, and almost everybody had correct coat and colour. Just a few had dilute spots, and one puppy needs to clear up in colour. I also found that teeth and bite was better than I often see. No bad bites and only a few missing teeth, well done!

Only a few dogs carried their tails high, but that said I found that a big percentage of the dogs with stubby or half tails, had a kink. I have been living with the docking ban since the breed was FCI recognized, and it IS hereditary, so please take it seriously. I didn't see many round eyes, and only few had the big ears that often goes together with them. Front ends, as some might know my biggest focus point, were off course of different quality, but I did only see very few who were really standing forward, lacking forechest and displaying unsound front movement.

My Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex was of very high quality, and I was happy to hear that the bitch was made up to a Champion on the day.

### Baby Puppy Dog

1. Knott's Zuni Someone You Loved Fallcat (imp)- Very handsome male puppy, with nice filled out muzzle and chin; well set ears that could be smaller; nicely angulated front and rear and nice tight paws; Good bone and chest with enough forechest; right now a bit leggy; correct coat and colour for the age. Moves well from all sides. A very promising pup. **Best Baby Puppy in Show**
2. Heggie's Talard It Wasn't Me- Another handsome puppy; Nice proportions, good bone and feet; Correct chest with nice forechest; well angulated front and rear; a bit long in loin and high in rear right now; correct coat and colour. Moves well.

### Minor Puppy Dog

1. Cowley's All Embracing A Time for Trusting with Sparkaway (imp Skj)- Correct proportion; enough filled out in muzzle and skull; correct high set and carried ears of good size; enough angulation front and rear; chest of good length and depth, with enough forechest; correct colour and coat; a bit flat in croup; moved with nice strides, correct from all sides. A nice pup that needs time.
2. Douglas and Moisi's Winstead Follow My Heart- Well-proportioned male puppy; well filled out muzzle and chin, skull needs time; well set ears; well bodied up; enough angulation front and rear; moves well.

### Puppy Dog

1. Browns Archie Labakan Slovakia (imp Skj) A well-balanced puppy. Well filled out muzzle and skull for the age; well angulated; correct length and depth of chest, and a very nice forechest; nice strong loin and correct sloping croup; a little high in hock. Moves correct from all sides. **Best Puppy Dog, Best Junior Dog, Best Puppy in Show, Best Junior in Show**
2. Henderson & McDevitt's Caronlea Sea's The Day (CPW'24) Well-proportioned of bigger size; muzzle could be better filled out; would like more chin; low set rose ears; well angulated front with enough in rear; correct chest; correct colour and coat; moves with energy.

### Junior Dog

1. Browns Archie Labakan Slovakia (imp Skj)
2. Goodey & Gibbons Wispafetes Simply a Smartie- Very nice junior; well-

proportioned with correct filled out head and well set ears; well angulated; correct chest with nice forechest; a bit steep croup. Moves well.

### Yearling Dog

1. Jarram, Jarram & Whittingham's Chalkville Strike A Deal with Kashaella JW- A young dog with correct proportions; Could be better filled out in muzzle and chin: well set ears; upright shoulder; correct long upper arm, good spring of ribs, but chest could be longer and have more forechest; a bit long in loin; would like more bend of stifle; nice sloping croup. Sound mover.

2. Webster's Louiston Hellfire- Nice head but have missing teeth; upright shoulder and short upper arm; correct spring of ribs but would like more forechest; long in loin; nice bend of stifle. Moves well.

#### Novice Dog

1. Heggie's Winstead Brave New World Jr Jun Ch- Well-proportioned dog in good balance; nice masculine head; ears could be higher set and a touch smaller; nice filled out chest of good length and enough forechest; well angulated; hocks could be shorter. Moves well.
2. Wilson, Wilson & Gibbons Wispafetes Chasing The Ace at Ozways (Al)- Nice masculine dog; well filled out head with high set ears of good size; well angulated front and rear; pasterns a bit weak; well bodied with nice forechest; long in loin; moves ground covering.

#### Post Graduate Dog

1. Pugh, McTaggart and Mackenzie's Northbay Xsells Can't B'leaf My I's (imp USA)- Strong young male; correct proportions; nice head with slightly low set ears; correct spring of ribs and forechest; well angulated front and rear. Moves well from all sides.
2. Harvey's Weather The Storm- Nice strong head with rose ears; balanced angulation; slightly weak pastern; well filled out in body; long in loin.

#### Limit Dog

1. Downes' Damani Dream Miramax- Nice masculine male; well filled out head with high set ears of good size. Well angulated front and rear; correct length and depth of chest with nice forechest; slightly long in loin; moves well coming, but a bit narrow in rear.
2. Goodey and Gibbons' Wispafetes Real and True- Nice strong male; well filled out head with high set rose ear; balanced angulation; strong back; carries tail high on the move; Moves well.

#### Open Dog

1. Timperon's Louiston Outlander with Triforce- Well-proportioned male, masculine head that could have a bit stronger chin; nice high set and small ears; enough angulation front and rear; nice spring of ribs and enough forechest; would like chest a bit longer; good topline and correct sloping croup. Moves well.
2. Hutchcroft's Allmark One of These Days- Nicely proportioned male; strong head with well-set ears of good size; enough angulation front and rear; pasterns could be stronger; well bodied up, but chest a bit short and and loin a bit long; enough forechest; Sound mover.

#### Veteran Dog

1. Mc Taggart's Jack To A King Des Terres De Khairyaca- Beautiful old man! Masculine head with well-set ears; nice strong body; well angulated front and rear; sound and ground covering on the move. **Best Veteran Dog, Best Veteran in Show**
2. Colborne's UK CH SA Ch Mysticlight I'm So Handsome (imp ZAF)- Another well- kept old man. Strong head with well-set ears; balanced angulation; strong body; very sound mover for the age.

#### Special Red Merle Dog

1. Zettin's Ch Almond Cookie of Moon and Stars- Well-proportioned and strong male; masculine head; well filled out in muzzle, skull and chin. correct high set ears of good size; chest with nice spring of ribs, good length, depth and with correct forechest; well angulated front and rear; strong back. Moves well from all sides. **CC, Reserve Best in Show, Best Opposite Sex in Show**
2. Bothwell's Norcis Slippery Jack JW- Slightly square dog; strong head with well- set ears, chin could be stronger; Balanced angulation; chest could be longer and have more forechest; strong loin; nicely sloping croup; Moves well.

#### Special Blue Merle Dog

1. Marucco's Ch America's Blue Sweetheart of Moon and Stars- Nice strong male with good proportions; filled out muzzle and skull; slightly big ears; enough angulation in front, but could do with better bend of stifle; nice spring of ribs; enough forechest; moves well from side and coming, but narrow in rear.
2. Heggie's Talard Welcome to the Jungle- Well-proportioned dog; strong head, that could do with more chin; strong body with slightly long loin; balanced angulation; flat croup; sound mover.

#### Special Black Dog

1. Brown's Archie Labakan Slovakia (imp SKJ)
2. Morley's Trijem Three Times the Magic- Nice strong boy; well-proportioned

head; high set ears of good size; enough angulated both ends; a bit long in loin; moves fluently.

### Special Red Dog

1. Knott's Shalako's Come HellR High Water (imp USA)- Masculine dog with good proportions; Well filled out muzzle and skull; small, high set and carried ears; Strong body with correct forechest; well angulated front and rear. Moves very well. **RCC**
2. McKinnon's Dialynne Enzo Ferrari- Nice male with good proportions; correct masculine head, but needs more chin; high set ears; balanced angulation; nice body; a bit long in loin; rolls in back on the move; a bit narrow going away.

### Baby Puppy Bitch

1. Cowley's Nebesniy Aljans River NAF TAF- Nice feminine bitch; well filled out Muzzle and skull; High set ears that could be smaller; strong bone; enough angulation front and rear; well sprung ribs and enough forechest; Strong loin; correct sloping croup; colour could be clearer. Moves well.

### Minor Puppy Bitch

1. Mackenzie's Shepherds of Paradise U'R My Gal (imp Fra)- Nicely balanced puppy; well filled out muzzle and skull; ears could be higher set; enough angulation front and rear correct cheat and forechest for the age. Moves very well from all sides. **Best Puppy Bitch, Reserve Best Puppy in Show**
2. Hodges' Jopium Dark and Demure- Strong, well-proportioned puppy; nice well filled out head and body; high set ears of good size; Balanced angulation; correct length of chest but needs more forechest; strong back; flat croup; moves well.

### Junior Bitch

1. Harlow, Birkett & McDowell's Birkcross The Beat Goes On- Nicely balanced bitch; feminine head; correct high set ears; enough angulation in front and very nice bend of stifle; Well filled out chest and enough forechest; nice tight feet; moves very well from all sides. **Best Junior Bitch**
2. Wispafetes Give Us A Twirl- Feminine bitch of good size; Nice head; well set and carried ears; balanced angulation; would like more forechest; moves well.

### Yearling Bitch

1. King & Myall's Altussi All That Razzmatazz- Well-proportioned bitch; well filled out muzzle and skull; a bit steep stop; correct small, high set ears; balanced angulation; needs to mature in body; nice forechest; pasterns could be stronger; moves very well.
2. Thomson & Forbes' Louiston Defying Gravity with Karensbrae- Feminine head; High set and carried ears; balanced angulation; correct filled out chest, very nice mover.

### Novice Bitch

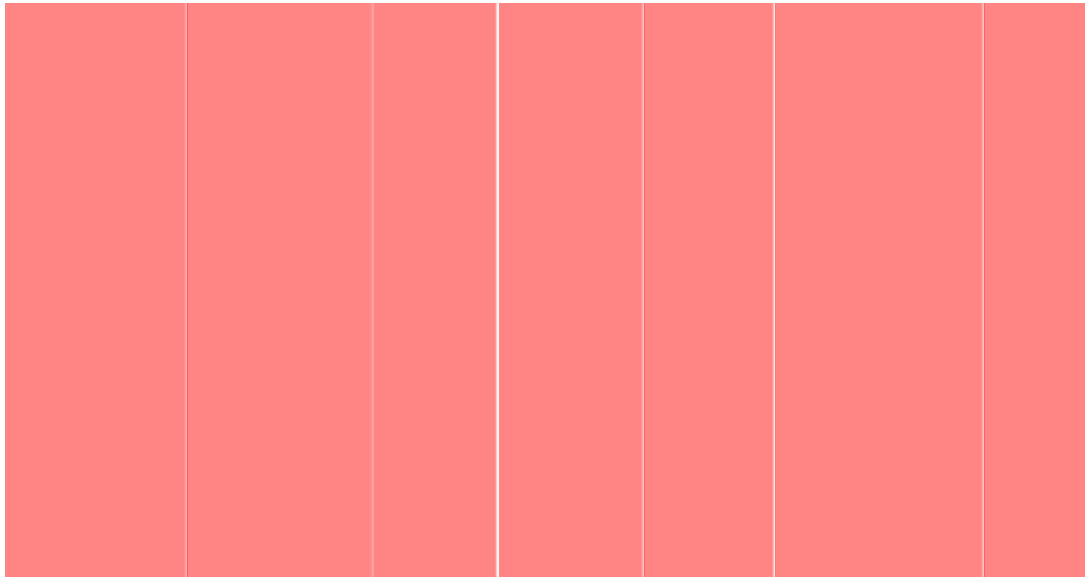
1. Wiley's Trijem Mischief Managed- Very nice balanced bitch; correct filled out head and high set ears; enough angulation front and rear; nice firm body and correct forechest; hock could be shorter; Moves very well.
2. Wilson & Gibbons' Wispafetes Give Us A Twirl- Well-proportioned bitch; well filled out muzzle and skull; well set ears; balanced angulation; well bodied, and chest of good length; would like better forechest; nice sloping croup; moves well a bit uneven in front.

### Post Graduate Bitch

1. Scanlan's Franmar Blue Mystique- Feminine bitch on the big side; well proportioned; filled out muzzle and skull; ears of good size, set high and carried correct; balanced angulation; moves very well.
2. Meads' Altussi Gypsy Queen at Kexican- Well-proportioned bitch; feminine; nice skull and muzzle; high set ears; balanced angulation; nice spring of ribs; a bit long in loin; moves well.

### Limit Bitch

1. Bothwell's Norcis Summer Truffle JW- Nice feminine bitch; well proportioned; muzzle, chin and skull well filled out; correct high set ears of correct size; well angulated front and enough bend of stifle; well filled out body of good length and with nice forechest; slightly flat croup. Moves very well. **RCC**



2. Smith & Smith's Birkcross Curtain Call- Feminine bitch; nicely filled out muzzle and skull; high set ears of good size; balanced angulation; well filled out body for the age; chest could be longer and have more forechest; Moves well.

#### Open Bitch

1. Colborne's SA Ch Mysticlight Jazz Onthebayou (imp ZAF) - Well balanced bitch of correct proportions; correct filled out muzzle and skull; nice high set ears of good size; well laid-back shoulder and nice bend of stifle; chest of correct length and depth; nice forechest; strong loin; moves with ground covering strides, true from all sides. **BCC, Best In Show**
2. Gibbons & Spencer's Wispafete Once Upon A Dream- Well-proportioned bitch; cute, well filled out head; High set ears; balanced angulation; correct filled out chest, moves nicely from all sides.

#### Veteran Bitch

1. Gibbons and Spencer's Ir Ch UK Ch Austrian Dream Cupcake To Go with Wispafete JW ShCm Ir JCh CJW16 (imp) Nice old lady; very feminine; correct muzzle, but could do with more chin; high set and carried ears; balanced angulation, firm body; moves very well. **Best Veteran Bitch, Reserve Best Veteran in Show**
2. Fuller's Ch Trijem Think Outside the Box AW(B)- Feminine strong bitch; well fill out head; high set ears; balanced angulation; correct forechest. Moves very well.

#### Special Red Merle Bitch

1. Blyton & Gibbons' Wispafete Light My Fire- Beautiful feminine bitch; well filled out head; high set ears that could be smaller; well angulated; nice tight body; could have more forechest; moves well from all sides.

#### Special Blue Merle Bitch

1. Scanlan's Franmar Blue Mystique

#### Special Black Bitch

1. Bothwell's Norcis Dusky Disco JW- Feminine bitch; well filled out muzzle, chin and skull; high set and carried ears; balanced angulation; nice spring of ribs, and correct length of chest; would like more forechest; flat croup. Sound mover.
2. Simpson & Simpson's Amberslade Santa Ana Breeze at Javison- Nice feminine head with slightly big rose ears; balanced angulation; nice strong body; a bit long in loin; correct sloping croup; moves well , a bit close and uneven in rear.

#### Special Red Bitch

1. Douglas, Douglas & Douglas' Winstead Change of Heart for Talard Ir J Ch C.I.B- J (imp)- Feminine bitch of the bigger size; correct muzzle and skull; high set and carried ears of nice size; balanced angulation; good length of chest; enough forechest; strong back; flat croup. Sound mover.

2. Herraty's Razkiah Fizzing Whizzbee- Well-proportioned bitch; feminine head that is a bit wedge formed head that lacks chin; correct high set small ears; enough angulation front and rear; nice body; sound mover.
